

#### **POLICY UPDATE: OCTOBER 2022**

## Regional / National

**Transport:** Several Northern Chambers met with Transport for the North and the Northern Regional Assembly to help push the case for improved connectivity and continue building our business case.

Disruption and uncertainty in the Conservative Party and government in recent weeks has led to the planned letter on HS2 and NPR being shelved for now. With a planned statement on the country's finances and tax and spend plans due in the autumn (later set for 17 Nov), a decision will be taken after that.

**Skills & Education**: Staff are being sought to undertake the Local Skills Improvement Plans (LSIPs) project that the Chamber is over-seeing for both West and North Yorkshire.

**Policy Department – new member:** Alice Ingram has been recruited to the team as the Business Engagement Manager for York & North Yorkshire. (Alice, currently with the Ad:Venture team, starts on 1 Nov.)

#### **Bradford**

**Property & Planning:** A meeting has been held with consultants WSP, commissioned by the Council to undertake a significant piece of work that includes assessing employment land and housing need in the future. The Chamber's difference of opinion with the Council on future need has been made clear, and the topic will again be aired at a full Forum event in November.

**Regeneration:** New plans for Odsal Stadium and surrounding area were discussed at Leadership Group. Funding and delivery were among key questions asked by group members, many of whom had witnessed earlier proposals come and go.

### Leeds

**Property, Transport & Planning:** The Property Forum on 18 October was well-attended. Presentations on transport, regeneration and the Local Plan were well-received, as Chamber events returned after a summer hiatus.

Waterfront: The Steering Group met after a long hiatus. The Charter is to be updated

### York & North Yorkshire

**Devolution:** The Chamber had a significant presence at the York & North Yorkshire LEP Business Summit on 21 October. The plan to deliver devolution for the area, and the importance of getting businesses involved were common threads throughout the afternoon.

**Property Forum:** Steering Group met on 3 Oct, largely to outline the details of the November event, and consider future topics for next year.
